

Bachelor of Arts with a major in English Language Arts for Educators

Students interested in continuing towards a secondary education certification will transition into the [English Language Arts for Educators, B.A./Teaching in Secondary Education, MAT, Combined B.A./MAT](#). At the undergraduate level, the Combined BA/MAT program allows students to apply for and receive delayed admission into the MAT program.

One second semester (or higher) language course	FREN, GRMN, JAPN, SPAN 122, 201 <i>or</i> 202 OR SIGN 162, 163 <i>or</i> 164

***Please Note: Education majors must complete WRT 1060 (or its equivalent) with a minimum grade of B or 3.0.**

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from Lansing CC, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit the transfer credits that can be used toward requirements, **it is highly recommended that students work with both an OU (school/college) academic adviser and their Lansing CC counselor to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.**

TRANSFERRING WITH THE MICHIGAN TRANSFER AGREEMENT (MTA):

When choosing to complete MTA to satisfy General Education, please confirm the best courses to take to fulfill the agreement with your academic adviser at Lansing CC or at the [Lansing CC MTA](#) website. To most efficiently satisfy OU's transferable General Education requirements, you are also encouraged to reference the [Lansing CC General Education Transfer Guide](#) and select the following:

- One course from OU's **Writing Foundations** category (**B/3.0 minimum required for education majors**) (*this serves as an MTA English Composition course and is a prerequisite for coursework at OU*)

TRANSFERRING WITHOUT MTA:

If you intend to transfer without MTA, you can choose to complete additional coursework to fulfill OU's individual General Education categories instead. For this major, the College of Arts and Sciences Exploratory Requirement is met with required coursework.

Oakland University will always honor the **MACRAO transfer agreement** and apply it to the General Education requirement the same as MTA.

The College of Arts and Sciences requires that a minimum of 16 credits in the major be completed at Oakland University.
