#### TRANSFERRING WITH THE MICHIGAN TRANSFER AGREEMENT (MTA):

When choosing to complete MTA to satisfy General Education, please confirm the best courses to take to fulfill the agreement with your academic adviser at Lansing or at the <u>Lansing MTA Approved Courses</u> website. Completing MTA when following this major guide will satisfy OU's transferrable General Education requirements.

# Additional course requirements for MTA when following this major guide (minimum 30 credit hours required for MTA):

ENGL 121 or 131 and ENGL 122 or 132 (required prerequisite for coursework at OU)

One MTA Approved Math course (can be satisfied by MATH or STAT elective options above)

One MTA Approved Natural Sciences course (can be satisfied by CHEM or PHYS elective options above)

One MTA Approved Social Sciences course (can be satisfied by SOCL 120)

Two MTA Approved Humanities or Fine Arts courses

### **TRANSFERRING WITHOUT MTA:**

If you intend to transfer without MTA, you can choose to complete additional coursework to fulfill OU's individual General Education categories instead. When following this major guide, please reference the <u>Lansing General Education Transfer</u> Guide for the Lansing courses that satisfy these specific OU General Education categories:

### NOTES:

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from Lansing, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit how much transfer credit can be used toward requirements, it is highly recommended that students work with both an OU academic adviser and their Lansing academic adviser to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.

Oakland University will always honor the **MACRAO transfer agreement** and apply it to the General Education requirement the same as MTA.
