When choosing to complete MTA to satisfy General Education, please confirm the best courses to take to fulfill the agreement with your academic adviser at NMC or at the <u>NMC MTA Approved Courses</u> website. Completing MTA when following this major guide will satisfy OU's transferrable General Education requirements.

# Additional course requirements for MTA when following this major guide (minimum 30 credit hours required for MTA):

### TRANSFERRING WITHOUT MTA:

If you intend to transfer without MTA, you can choose to complete additional coursework to fulfill OU's individual General Education categories instead. ### NOTES:

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from NMC, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit how much transfer credit can be used toward requirements, <u>it is</u> <u>highly recommended that students work with both an OU academic adviser and their NMC academic adviser to</u> <u>maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements</u>.

Oakland University will always honor the **MACRAO transfer agreement** and apply it to the General Education requirement the same as MTA.
