Available electives for this specialization must be approved by the ENV department adviser

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from OCC, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit the transfer credits that can be used toward requirements, <u>it is</u> <u>highly recommended that students work with both an OU (school/college) academic adviser and their OCC</u> <u>counselor to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements</u>.

TRANSFERRING WITH THE MICHIGAN TRANSFER AGREEMENT (MTA):

When choosing to complete MTA to satisfy General Education, please confirm the best courses to take to fulfill the agreement with your academic adviser at OCC or at the <u>OCC MTA Approved Courses</u> website. In order to completely satisfy OU's transferable General Education requirements when following this major guide, please reference the <u>OCC</u> <u>General Education Transfer Guide</u> and select one course from OU's *Knowledge Applications* category (*this category may be satisfied by major if MAT 1740 is chosen for math requirement)*.

Additional course requirements for MTA when following this major guide (minimum 30 credit hours required for MTA): ENG 1510 or 1510E (MTA Approved Composition course)

ENG 1520 (MTA Approved Communications Course; this is a prerequisite for coursework at OU)

TRANSFERRING WITHOUT MTA:

If you intend to transfer without MTA, you can choose to complete additional coursework to fulfill OU's individual General Education categories instead. When following this major guide, please reference the <u>OCC General Education Transfer</u> <u>Guide</u> for the OCC courses that satisfy these specific OU General Education categories:

EXPLORATORY REQUIREMENT:

Students with majors in the College of Arts and Sciences (CAS) must satisfy an exploratory requirement. This can be done by completing a double major or a CAS minor or concentration; or by completing a minimum of 12 credits in a single CAS rubric, outside of their major rubric. For additional options visit oakland.edu/exploratory . Please confirm transfer course choices with an OU CAS adviser. *Students using MTA or MACRAO must complete the exploratory requirement at Oakland University or another four-year institution.*

NOTES:

Oakland University will always honor the **MACRAO transfer agreement** and apply it to the General Education requirement the same as MTA.

The College of Arts and Sciences requires that a minimum of 16 credits in the major be completed at Oakland University.
