## NOTES:

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from Schoolcraft, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit how much transfer credit can be used toward requirements, <u>it is highly recommended that students work with both an OU academic adviser and their</u> <u>Schoolcraft academic adviser to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements</u>.

Oakland University will always honor the **MACRAO transfer agreement** and apply it to the General Education requirement the same as MTA.
