When choosing to complete MTA to satisfy General Education, please confirm the best courses to take to fulfill the agreement with your academic adviser at Schoolcraft or at the <a href="Schoolcraft MTA Approved Courses">Schoolcraft MTA Approved Courses</a> website. Completing MTA when following this major guide will satisfy OU's transferrable General Education requirements.

# Additional course requirements for MTA when following this major guide (minimum 30 credit hours required for MTA):

ENG 101 and ENG 102 (required prerequisite for coursework at OU)

One MTA Approved Math (can be satisfied by MATH elective options above)

One MTA Approved Natural Sciences course (can be satisfied by CHEM or PHYS elective options above)

One MTA Approved Social Sciences course (can be satisfied by SOC 201)

Two MTA Approved Humanities courses (one course can be satisfied by COMA 103)

### NOTES:

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from Schoolcraft, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit how much transfer credit can be used toward requirements, it is highly recommended that students work with both an OU academic adviser and their Schoolcraft academic adviser to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.

Oakland University will always honor the **MACRAO transfer agreement** and apply it to the General Education requirement the same as MTA.
