When choosing to complete MTA to satisfy General Education, please confirm the best courses to take to fulfill the agreement with your academic adviser at WCC or at the <u>WCC MTA Approved Courses</u> website. Completing MTA when following this major guide will satisfy OU's transferrable General Education requirements.

NOTES:

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from Washtenaw, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit how much transfer credit can be used toward requirements, <u>it is highly recommended that students work with both an OU academic adviser and their</u> <u>Washtenaw academic adviser to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements</u>.

Oakland University will always honor the **MACRAO transfer agreement** and apply it to the General Education requirement the same as MTA.
