NOTES:

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from WC3, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit how much transfer credit can be used toward requirements, <u>it is</u> <u>highly recommended that students work with both an OU academic adviser and their WC3 academic adviser to</u> <u>maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements</u>.

The program also offers a unique Orthotist and Prosthetist Assistant Studies (OPA) specialization, which equips students with the skills needed for one-on-one patient care under the direction of a certified orthotist or prosthetist. Students interested in this specialization can also transfer ALH 110 from WC3 to OU.

OU's <u>ECLIPSE program</u>, a unique community-engaged leadership initiative, is one of only a few health-science specific leadership programs in the country.

Oakland University will always honor the **MACRAO transfer agreement** and apply it to the General Education requirement the same as MTA.
