RENEWAL OF ELSEVIER SUBSCRIPTION AGREEMENT A Recommendation

- 1. <u>Division and Department:</u> Academic Affairs, University Libraries
- 2. <u>Introduction:</u> The University Libraries maintain a subscription to Elsevier publications and products, which currently includes access to the ScienceDirect platform, Elsevier's Complete Collection of articles from journal titles published since 2011, and its Cell Press Collection of articles from journal titles published since 1995. ScienceDirect is a leading online platform of multi-disciplinary, peer-reviewed literature with especially strong support for STEM research.

It is requested that the Board authorize the Senior Vice President for Academic Affairs and Provost to execute a three-year renewal Subscription Agreement with Elsevier, for a term from January 1, 2020 ending on December 31, 2022, at a cost not to exceed \$1,487,732.

- 3. Previous Board Action: None.
- **4.** <u>Budget Implications:</u> Annual subscription costs will be \$473,938 in the first year and will increase 4.6% and 4.5%, respectively, in the next two years. Total costs will be covered by the University Libraries budget.
- **5.** Educational Implications: Access to the Elsevier publication data on the online platform and the journal collections of full text directly contribute to student learning and to research conducted by Oakland University faculty, students, and staff.
- 6. Personnel Implications: None.
- 7. <u>University Reviews/Approvals:</u> This recommendation was prepared by the University Libraries and reviewed by the Office of the Provost.

RESOLVED, that the Senior Vice President and Provost is authorized to execute a three-year Elsevier Subscription Agreement, at a cost not to exceed \$1,487,732.
