Registration Information:

To register to attend the Engineering & IT Career Fair, log into OUCareerLink.com by clicking on the "Employer" button. Log in with your username and password or create a new employer account. If you create a new employer account, it may take up to a few days for approval before you can register for the career fair.

Once you are logged in, click on the "Events" tab then click on "Register" next to "2015 Engineering & IT Career Fair" to complete the registration form and submit.

Once your registration is approved by Career Services, you will be emailed a link to pay by credit card or you can request an invoice to pay by check.

Employer Fee Payment and Event Cancellation Policy:

Employer event registration fees must be submitted within 30 days following the event. Fees are non-refundable for an organization cancelling within four business days prior to the event. Future event registration for an organization with an unpaid balance due to non-remittance, late cancellation or non-attendance will not be approved until full payment is received. Access to all other recruiting services will also be denied.

Parking:

As with most college campuses, parking at Oakland University can be difficult during the academic year. We ask that you enter the university at the Squirrel Road entrance to either Library Drive (across from Cross Creek) or Pioneer Drive, which will take you directly to the designated parking area, Parking Lot 35.

Shuttles will be available from Parking Lot 35 to transport you and your materials near the entrance of the Recreation Center. Please wait by the sign that says "Career Fair Shuttle Pick Up". The morning shuttle service will be available from 8:30 – 10:30 am. If you arrive after 10:30 please call (248) 370-3250 so transportation can be arranged. The afternoon shuttle service will be available beginning at 1:00 pm. Shuttle service will only be provided from Parking Lot 35 to the Recreation Center. Please look for the large white vans marked "Career Fair Shuttle".

There may be some parking spaces available in other parking lots, however, shuttle service will only be available from Lot 35.
