A cumulative GPA of 2.0 is required overall and in the major.

At least 16 credits in PSY courses must be completed at Oakland University.

As a general rule, psychology coursework more than 10 years old is not accepted for credit toward the major. Only in exceptionally rare cases will the department review such courses for acceptance as credit toward the major.

**PSY 251 requires a prerequisite of both PSY 250 and competency in intermediate algebra. Competency is demonstrated by completing MTH 062-Intermediate Algebra, having an ACT math score of 22 or higher, or taking the math placement exam and achieving a level "R" through the Mathematics and Statistics department. Students should plan to complete the math prerequisites as soon as possible if placement is at or below the MTH 062 level.

Students who would like to pursue Honors in psychology should identify a faculty sponsor by the end of their junior year.
