Competency is demonstrated by completing MTH 0662 (Intermediate Algebra), having an ACT math score of 22 or higher, having an SAT math score of 520 or higher, or taking the math placement exam and achieving a level "R" through the Mathematics and Statistics department. Students should plan to complete the math prerequisites as soon as possible if placement is at or below the MTH 0662 level.
