Note:-*AH 3000 is offered every other year. Students must take the course when it is offered either during their junior or senior year.

-Required areas include- *Non-Western*: AH 3010, 3020, 3030, 3040, 3050, 3060, 3070, 3080, 3110, 3240 or 3890. *Ancient/Medieval*: AH 3110, 3120, 3130, 3220, 3230, 3240, 3630 or 3890.

Renaissance/Baroque: AH 3080, 3220, 3310, 3320, 3350, 3610, 3620, 3630 or 3890. *American/Modern*: AH 3410, 3420, 3430, 3440, 3510, 3540, 3550, 3560, 3610, 3650, 3651, 3710 or 3890.

- AH courses that appear in multiple areas may count toward only one (there are four required areas) for degree requirements.

-The term “elective” may not be completely “free” in that this table does not address the university requirements of G.E. Integration or 32 credits at the 3000/4000 level.
