Per Michigan Department of Education (MDE) requirements, beginning as of Fall 2018, the Graduate Certificate in Teaching English as a Second Language, offered by the Department of Linguistics, will be altered as follows:

- The credit requirement will be raised from 20 to 24. The 4-credit class ALS 5589 Special Needs and Second Language Acquisition will be added to bring the credit total to 24.
