HOW TO APPLY FOR MAJOR STANDING: Studio Art K-12

In order to be admitted to Major Standing in OU's Studio Art K-12 Education program, you must have completed <u>all</u> of the following:

Art Education Major Standing Application	
A signed program plan from your faculty adviser.	
Felony Misdemeanor Form	
Art Education "Experiences with Children" Form showing your 35 hours completed	
Passing scores on each of the 3 Professional Readiness (Basic Skills) Test components of	
the Michigan Test for Teacher Certification (MTTC). Students may also use ACT or MME	
scores (from 1989 forward) to satisfy sections of the PRE according to the following chart:	
ACT Score of:	MME Score of:
Math = 22 or higher	Math = 1116 or higher
Reading = 22 or higher	Reading = 1108 or higher
Combined English/Writing = 24 (recalculated)	Writing = 1129 or higher

Once you are admitted to Major Standing, you may register for the first set of "Professional" courses.

IN ORDER FOR YOUR APPLICATION TO BE PROCESSED, YOU MUST ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURES:

- 1. Make sure that you have satisfied each of the requirements listed above. NOTE: We <u>will</u> accept Major Standing appointments from students who are currently enrolled in EED 312 or SED 300. This is the only exception that will be made to the requirements listed above.
- 2. Complete the Art Education Major Standing Application and Art Education Experiences with Children Form (available at http://www.oakland.edu/sehs/advising/arted)
- 3. Meet with your faculty adviser in Art Education to obtain a **signed program plan**. Make a photocopy to <u>bring</u> to your Major Standing appointment.
