A Note Regarding Upcoming Changes to Introductory Physics Courses

Beginning in the fall 2014 semester, the 5-credit physics introductory courses, PHY 101/102/151/152 (lab integrated with the lecture) will become 4-credit lecture courses. The PHY 101/151 lecture courses will have a one-credit lab corequisite, PHY 110 – General Physics Lab I. The PHY 102/152 lecture courses will have a one-credit lab corequisite, PHY 111 – General Physics Lab II.

LECTURE ONLY: Students who need to take the lecture course, but don't need to take a lab, should register for the 4-credit alternative courses as described below. If the student is unable to register for the 4-credit alternative courses due to a major restriction, the student should meet with their academic adviser, and the adviser should e-mail the physics department (searight@oakland.edu), giving permission to the physics secretary to override the major restriction so that the student can register for the alternative course.
