Presidents / UHR Monthly Meeting Report

- Ron Watson presented information regarding Flexible Work Arrangement to the Board of Trustees on October 14, 2019
 - Response from BOT was positive.
- Compensation Guidelines Update
 - Back from legal with significant changes and is currently being reviewed by UHR.
 - Will likely be brought back to Compensation Committee for review.
- AP Manual
 - Still in legal and review has not yet started.
 - Not likely to be completed before the December BOT meeting.
- Performance Management
 - Presented proposal to purchase Cornerstone to cabinet who asked for more information.
 - UHR staff is working to provide more references.
 - Association Presidents will be invited to a presentation to cabinet in the near future
 - PeopleSoft software system contract was renewed for three years and if Cornerstone is purchased, UHR believes having both systems will allow for a more seamless transition.
- Youth Policy is effective.
 - The policy and information on the process is on the OU website.
- Mentorship program was successful and will be returning in the 2020 year!

Old Business

- AP Association wrote a formal memo regarding the proposed changes to the manual addressing the changes AP Association supports and those not supported.
- AP Sponsored Student Emergency Fund
 - Members of the AP Assembly, AP Association and APs campus-wide are joining forces to help OU students during the All University Fund Drive (AUFDF). A special fund is being created, the AP Sponsored Student Emergency Award, which will help students who encounter an unforeseen financial emergency or events which would otherwise prevent them from continuing their education at Oakland. Our goal is to have as many APs on campus as possible participating to create the maximum impact for students in need.  - As of 10/30/2019, more than \$1,700 has been raised!
 - Currently, the AP Sponsored Student is within the Top 5 funds. If the fund remains in the Top 5, an additional money amount from the President's office would be awarded to the fund. Please promote!

 - Benchmarking other businesses to review Community Service Time Off policies/processes.
 - Proposal: 8 hours to all employees to complete Community Service Time Off.
 - Ties into OU's third strategic goal, "Become a leader in serving the needs and aspirations of our communities and region through expanded community relationships, institutional reputation and visibility and engagement".
- Work Life Balance
 - Work team includes Don Ritenburgh, Marie VanBuskirk, Marie Ebner-Smith
 - 802 number of requests submitted (not 802 individual people), 283 approved with a large number of technical issues (saved, submitted, ect)
 - Comment from the AP Reps that the Help Desk is feeling the brunt of the Remote Work technology issues employees are experiencing.
