Bachelor of Interdisciplinary Studies

Effective December 1, 2019 - November 30, 2024

1. Complete any associate degree from Henry Ford College.
 - a. Associate in Arts, Associate of Business, Associate of Fine Arts, Associate in Science, Associate in Applied Science, or Associate in General Studies.
2. Before transferring, complete the Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA) or OU General Education categories to ensure maximum transferability of 88 credits.
3. At OU complete BIS and University requirements for degree. This can be completed in a minimum of 32 credits.
4. Meet with a BIS Adviser to complete required application steps to achieve major-standing in Interdisciplinary Studies. This includes course work selection, written rationale, faculty mentor meeting, and approval by the BIS faculty council.
