

Articulation Agreement Between Oakland University and Kirtland Community College For a Bachelor's of Interdisciplinary Studies

Effective October 1, 2020- September 30, 2025

Curriculum Guide

- 1. Complete any associate degree from Kirtland Community College.
 - a. Associate in Accounting, Associate in Business Administration, Associate in Applied Science, or Associate in Science and Arts.
- 2. Before transferring, complete the Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA) or OU General Education categories to ensure maximum transferability of 88 credits.
- 3. At OU complete BIS and University requirements for degree. This can be completed in a minimum of 32 credits.
- 4. Meet with a BIS Adviser to complete required application steps to achieve major-standing in Interdisciplinary Studies. This includes course work selection, written rationale, faculty mentor meeting, and approval by the BIS faculty council.
