- 1. Complete any associate degree from Mid Michigan College.
 - a. Associate in Applied Science, Associate in Arts, or Associate in Science.
- 2. Before transferring, complete the Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA) or OU General Education categories to ensure maximum transferability of **88 credits**.
- 3. At OU complete BIS and University requirements for degree. This can be completed in a minimum of 32 credits.
- 4. Meet with a BIS Adviser to complete required application steps to achieve major-standing in Interdisciplinary Studies. This includes course work selection, written rationale, faculty mentor meeting, and approval by the BIS faculty council.
