Report Behavior(/deanofstudents/behaviorconcern)

1. Cheating on assignments and examinations
2. Plagiarizing the work of others
3. Cheating on lab reports
4. Falsifying records
5. Unauthorized collaboration on assignments

- Email/texts/phone

Ways We Can Assist

- Faculty consultation with DOS Office
- DOS meeting with the student
- Referral to Counseling
- Referral to D.S.S. – Disability Support Services
- Medical Withdrawal
- Involve family
- Conduct Referral
- Interim Measures: PNG or Interim Suspension
- Welfare Checks in conjunction with police
