- 5. Respectful and fair toward all students
- 6. Engaged students in active learning (i.e. class activities, assignments)
- 7. Responsive to students learning (return assignments promptly, provide feedback and support)

Course Qualities

- 1. Followed the course description, syllabus and learning outcomes
- Provided new knowledge, skills and/or attitudes that will help me in future courses, life or career (Provided meaningful, relevant learning experiences)
- 3. Required deep learning (i.e. application, critical thinking, problem solving, creative expression)
- 4. Assignments and assessments were reasonably challenging
