Readmitted Student Enrollment Guide

Congratulations on your readmission to Oakland University and welcome back!

Please complete the following steps before starting your classes.

STEP 1: REACTIVATE YOUR ACCOUNT

- You were assigned a Grizzly ID number when you were initially admitted to OU. If you don't remember your Grizzly ID, please call Undergraduate Admissions at (248) 370-3360.
- Make sure you have your six-digit PIN number. If you cannot remember your PIN, please reset it at the NetID Management Page at netid.
 oakland.edu. Choose "Reset your Grizzly ID PIN." Go to the Oakland University SAIL page at sail.oakland.edu. Choose "Login to a Secure Area." Login using your Grizzly ID number and PIN.

You will first have to reestablish your relationship with the university by registering for classes before regaining a NetID, password and email account.

STEP 2: REGISTER FOR CLASSES

 All students are encouraged to meet with an academic adviser to create a plan of study, discuss degree requirements, and stay on track to graduate. Visit oakland.edu/advising to find an academic adviser in your desired major.

To register for classes:

- First visit oakland.edu/registrar/registration/regschedule to review the registration instructions.
- 2. Login to sail.oakland.edu using your Grizzly ID number and PIN.
- Select "Student Services" from the menu, then "Registration," then "Register for Classes."
- If you get an error while registering, you can locate the point of contact at oakland.edu/registrar/registration/registration-errors to assist you in resolving the requirement. Some courses require specific prerequisites; the department can verify that you meet the prerequisite and allow you to register. For other registration issues, please contact Registrar Services at (248) 370-3450.

DROPPING OR WITHDRAWING FROM CLASSES

STEP 3: SET UP NETID, PASSWORD AND EMAIL

After registering for classes you will be able to set up your NetID, password and student email:

- First visit the NetID Management Page at netid.oakland.edu. Select "Create NetID Account." Login with your Grizzly ID and PIN, then select a NetID and click "Submit."
- 2. Click on "Password Reset Page" and login with your Grizzly ID and PIN. Create a new password, then select "change password."
- You will now have the ability to access your MySAIL account at mysail.
 oakland.edu. Login using your NetID and password for access to
 important student information, including your OU email account,
 which should be checked regularly.

STEP 4: FINANCIAL SERVICES AND PAYMENT

Remember to complete the FAFSA as soon as possible beginning October 1 to see what you may qualify for, and use OU's federal school code of 002307. Go to oakland.edu/fafsa to learn more.
