Allergy Injection Policy

Allergy injections are simple and effective; however, severe reactions can occur. Please read our policy and sign below, indicating your understanding of the information.

Before obtaining allergy injections at GHC, patients will

- Have allergist administer the first dose from each new vial
- Be evaluated by a GHC provider
- Bring dosage records and serum from their allergists

After each injection

- Wait 30 minutes after each injection
- Report any reaction immediately to the GHC staff
- Report any delayed reactions to their allergist and GHC provider
- Inform the GHC Staff of any delay in obtaining their allergy injections as recommended by the allergist
- Provide GHC with any change in allergy injection dosing
- When University is closed for more than 2 days, patient will pick up their allergy serum and return to allergist for necessary injections

Patients experiencing a significant allergy injection reaction will:

- Agree to be evaluated by their allergist prior to returning to GHC for additional injections
