INTERNATIONAL STUDENT STATEMENT OF FINANCES

Statement of Finances

Before Oakland University can issue a "Certificate of Eligibility for Nonimmigrant Student Status" (SEVIS I-20 or DS-2019) for a student visa to enter the United States, the applicant must have an official admission offer to enroll in a graduate program and must provide the following documentation.

- 1.A Il tuition and fees for one academic year (based on international rates)
- 2.A Il living expenses associated with his/her stay in the U.S. while studying at Oakland University, including books and supplies, for one academic year
- 3.1 mmediate expenses upon arrival at the university (1,500.00 U.S. dollars)
- 4.F unds to purchase health insurance which meets Oakland University requirements

NOTE: ALL BANK STATEMENTS MUST BE WRITTEN IN ENGLISH AND CONTAIN THE BANKS OFFICIAL STAMP OR SEAL.

Estimated Tuition and Living Expenses

At the present time, it is estimated that an unmarried international student's tuition, living expenses, and health insurance for one academic year will total at least \$36,386 U.S. dollars (USD). This total does not include living expenses for the periods when oncampus housing is closed, for any family members who will accompany the student, nor all round-trip transportation expenses between the student's home country and Oakland University. The breakdown of these expenses in USD is as follows for each academic year:

The above fees and expenses are effective for the 2021-22 academic year (September 1, 2021 – September 1, 2022). To estimate expenses for an academic year beyond 2021-22, add an additional 10% of the total in order to cover anticipated increases. All fees and expenses are subject to change at the discretion of Oakland University.

Dependents

Add \$6,500.00 USD (including insurance) per year for the first dependent and \$4,900.00 USD per year for each additional dependent who will accompany you. (A dependent is a spouse of any age or a child 20 years of age or younger.)

Medical Insurance

The cost of medical care in the United States is very high. Should hospitalization become necessary, the associated expenses may total hundreds of dollars **per day**. The only effective protection is to purchase a medical insurance policy upon arrival in the United States. All international students are required to purchase and maintain health insurance which meets Oakland University requirements throughout their duration of studies while in the U.S. Oakland University makes such a policy available and it is required that all international students purchase it or provide evidence of coverage by an equivalent policy.
