

Dear Nurse Anesthesia Program Applicant,

We are pleased to inform you that the Oakland University Board of Trustees and the Council on Accreditation of Nurse Anesthesia Educational Programs approved the Oakland University-Beaumont Graduate Program of Nurse Anesthesia to offer a Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) degree for accepted students beginning fall 2018.

This represents a change in degree programs being offered by the School of Nursing. The MSN degree has been suspended and will no longer be conferred by Oakland University. Nurse Anesthesia is now offered exclusively through DNP completion.

All Fall 2018 applicants who have applied under the MSN application and wish to continue their application for the DNP must sign this form acknowledging that Oakland University's School of Nursing will not confer the MSN. This form also provides confirmation that applicants intend on pursuing the new DNP program in lieu of MSN. The DNP is 36 months in length versus 28 months and is 87 credits versus 58 credits. The projected cost of tuition for the DNP program is \$75,255.
