Collaborative Institutional Training Initiative (CITI) Training Module Instructions

For your Capstone requirement – each student needs to affiliate and complete at least one Institution's CITI course/module requirement.

- If you will be submitting an IRB to Oakland University please complete OU's CITI training
- If you will be submitting an IRB to Beaumont Health please complete William Beaumont Hospital's CITI training
- If you will be submitting an IRB to another institution please complete that institution's CITI training
- If you do not require an IRB (and have completed the IRB excusal form process) please complete William Beaumont Hospital's CITI training

Once you have completed the training courses – we will need you to print your Completion Reports to PDF and attach them to the CITI training row in your SmartSheets. (Instructions for printing reports are below, and you will need these reports once you are ready to submit your IRB applications.)

1) Go to the CITI training website (https://www.citiprogram.org) and Create an Account/register. If you have a pre-existing CITI account, you can skip to step 2.



 Go to the Main Menu. If you have previously affiliated with a different institution you will need to simply add Oakland University or William Beaumont Hospital Research Institute to your profile. (Any courses/modules you have preciously completed will populate into the OU or Beaumont learner groups).



If you only need to complete OU CITI Training modules, you are done setting up your learner groups. You should have the following course now populated in your OU CITI Courses. If you are conducting research at Beaumont Hospital, please continue to step 7.






Select Curriculum "Alternative 1"



Question 1: Make a selection only if your research involves animals




Question 2: Select "Mandatory-Biomedical Research Investigators and Key Personnel"

- 8) Hit the "submit" button at the bottom of the page, and the modules you will have to complete will be populated for you. You should have the following course now populated in your William Beaumont Hospital CITI Courses.

- 9) Once you have completed all the affiliations and course populating, you need to begin taking the courses/modules by clicking on the course title name, and then on the individual module names. Once you have completed the modules, you will see your score populated on the far right column. You will need to meet the minimum score requirements in order to pass the course (80%). After completion of all the modules in a course, your course status will change to 'completed'. CITI course completions are valid for 3 years.
- 10) To print and save your completion reports, click on the Institution and then on "My Reports" on the horizontal menu across the top of the screen.



- 11) Click on the "View" under the Completion Report Column for to open the report. A separate tab/window should open up with your completion report.
- 12) Go to your File>print option on your apple menu. In the call out box, select the PDF button in the lower left corner. Or, choose download, and save the pdf to your files. Be sure to change the file name to your name, the institution, and the course title (as you will have to save the report for each course and submit all of them with your IRB application).
