

Qualtrics Site License

Oakland University has invested in a site wide license for Qualtrics for online data collection and research. The current license is available to all faculty, students and staff who are currently employed or an active registered student at Oakland University.

The site wide license will only authenticate users using a valid Oakland NetID

School of Medicine utilizing Beaumont's Qualtrics license

If you used your Oakland NetID to establish your account with Beaumont's license, you cannot transfer your account to this site license. If you have used other login credentials (i.e. your personal home email), you can establish an account as a New User using Oakland's site wide license, noting that no data or surveys will transfer between the two brands.

How can I access Qualtrics?

When you first visit the Qualtrics site, you will be asked if you are a New User or have an Existing Account. : Select: New User

Qualtrics can be accessed in two ways:

The University App Store may direct you to install an agent first before you can gain to access the Qualtrics App.

Features Available in the campus site license:

- Unlimited accounts for all faculty, students and staff
- Unlimited phone and email support.
- License Fees are centrally funded

- Question Types (built in examples, radio button, checkbox, dropdown, text box, etc.)
- Unlimited Templates
- Language (Any, including Unicode)
- Prebuilt survey Themes
- Validate / Require Survey responses
- Randomize / Sort Answer Choices
- Accessible and 508 Compliant and Certified Surveys
- Unlimited data collection
- Analysis (Date import/export, Cross tabs, drill down, statistics, etc.)
- Exporting Data (cvs, excel, PDF, PowerPoint, SPSS, word)
