 - Entry Test Scores No entrance tests are required.
 - Statement of Purpose Fill out or copy/paste your goal statement here. (Should describe career experiences, responsibilities and explain reasons for wanting to enter the Education Specialist program and should include career goals)
 - Submit Application Once everything is complete, submit your application.
- Return to the "My Account" screen on the application to submit your **supplemental items**:
 - Curriculum Vita or Resume
 - Unofficial bachelor degree transcripts this will help your application get processed while you are waiting for your official transcripts to arrive.
 - Two Recommendation Requests You will need send a recommendation request electronically to two individuals using the online form provided. (Must provide valid email addresses.)
