MAJOR REQUIREMENTS

*Please Note: Education majors must complete WRT 1060 (or its equivalent) with a minimum grade of B or 3.0.

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from Delta, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit the transfer credits that can be used toward requirements, <u>it is</u> <u>highly recommended that students work with both an OU (school/college) academic adviser and their Delta</u> <u>counselor to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.</u>

TRANSFERRING WITH THE MICHIGAN TRANSFER AGREEMENT (MTA):

When choosing to complete MTA to satisfy General Education, please confirm the best courses to take to fulfill the agreement with your academic adviser at Delta or at the <u>Delta MTA</u> website. Completing MTA when following this major guide will satisfy OU's transferrable General Education requirements.
