**Additional course requirements for MTA when following this major guide  
(minimum 30 credit hours required for MTA):**

- ENGL (151 or 152H) **and** ENGL (152 or 152H) (required prerequisite for coursework at OU)
- One MTA Approved Math course (can be satisfied by MATH elective options above)
- One MTA Approved Natural Sciences course (can be satisfied by CHEM or PHYS elective options above)
- One MTA Approved Social Sciences course (can be satisfied by SOCI 201 or 201H)
- Two MTA Approved Humanities or Fine Arts courses
