If you intend to complete MTA when following this major guide, take (PSY 24000 or SPE 10500) or select another course from OU's **Knowledge Applications** category in order to satisfy OU's transferable General Education requirements.

**Additional course requirements for MTA when following this major guide  
(minimum 30 credit hours required for MTA):**

- ENG 10303 **and** ENG 10403 (required prerequisite for coursework at OU)
- One MTA Approved Math course (can be satisfied by MTH elective options above)
- One MTA Approved Natural Sciences course (can be satisfied by CHE elective options above)
- One MTA Approved Social Sciences course (can be satisfied by SOC 10100)
- Two MTA Approved Humanities or Fine Arts courses

**TRANSFERRING WITHOUT MTA:**

If you intend to transfer without MTA, you can choose to complete additional coursework to fulfill OU's individual General Education categories instead. **NOTES:**

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from Kirtland, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit how much transfer credit can be used toward requirements, **it is highly recommended that students work with both an OU academic adviser and their Kirtland academic adviser to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.**

Oakland University will always honor the **MACRAO transfer agreement** and apply it to the General Education requirement the same as MTA.
