If you intend to complete MTA when following this major guide, take (COMM 101 or PSYC 203) or select another course from OU's **Knowledge Applications** category in order to satisfy OU's transferable General Education requirements.

One MTA Approved Social Sciences course (can be satisfied by completing both (PSYC 201 **and** SOC 101)

Two MTA Approved Humanities or Fine Arts courses

TRANSFERRING WITHOUT MTA:

If you intend to transfer without MTA, you can choose to complete additional coursework to fulfill OU's individual General Education categories instead. NOTES:

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from Lake Michigan, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit how much transfer credit can be used toward requirements, **it is highly recommended that students work with both an OU academic adviser and their Lake Michigan academic adviser to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.**

Oakland University will always honor the **MACRAO transfer agreement** and apply it to the General Education requirement the same as MTA.
