#### MAJOR REQUIREMENTS

A maximum of 16 transfer credits may be used toward the major, in addition to the required 9 corequisite credits.

\*Please Note: Education majors must complete WRT 1060 (or its equivalent) with a minimum grade of B or 3.0.

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from Macomb, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit the transfer credits that can be used toward requirements, <u>it is</u> <u>highly recommended that students work with both an OU (school/college) academic adviser and their Macomb</u> <u>counselor to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.</u>
