**TRANSFERRING WITH THE MICHIGAN TRANSFER AGREEMENT (MTA):**

When choosing to complete MTA to satisfy General Education, please confirm the best courses to take to fulfill the agreement with your academic adviser at Mid Michigan or at the [Mid Michigan MTA Approved Courses](#) website. If you intend to complete MTA when following this major guide, take (COM 257; PHY 106, PHY 212, or (HES 100 or PSY 212)) or select another course from OU's **Knowledge Applications** category in order to satisfy OU's transferable General Education requirements.

**Additional course requirements for MTA when following this major guide (minimum 30 credit hours required for MTA):**

- ENG 111 **and** ENG 222 (required prerequisite for coursework at OU)
- One MTA Approved Math course (can be satisfied by MAT elective options above)
- One MTA Approved Natural Sciences course (can be satisfied by CHM or PHY elective options above)
- One MTA Approved Social Sciences course (can be satisfied by SOC 101)
- Two MTA Approved Humanities courses

**TRANSFERRING WITHOUT MTA:**

If you intend to transfer without MTA, you can choose to complete additional coursework to fulfill OU's individual General Education categories instead. **NOTES:**

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from Mid Michigan, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit how much transfer credit can be used toward requirements, **it is highly recommended that students work with both an OU academic adviser and their Mid Michigan academic adviser to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.**

Oakland University will always honor the **MACRAO transfer agreement** and apply it to the General Education requirement the same as MTA.
