MAJOR REQUIREMENTS

Oakland University Courses	Mott Community College Options
Select up to 4 courses from this list of English Electives:	ENGL 221, 222, 223, 225, 227, 231, 232, 235, 242, 253, 261 (only one of the 4 courses may come from these: ENGL 103, 220; MAET 180)

COREQUISITES: Select from the two options below

An introductory two-semester sequence in a foreign language:	ARBC, CHI, GERM, JAPA, RUSN, (111 and 112) or FREN 151 and 152 or SPAN 181 and 182
One semester of a foreign language at the second semester or higher:	ARBC, CHI, GERM, JAPA, RUSN, (112, 211 or 212) or FREN 152, 251 or 252 or SPAN 182, 281 or 282

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from Mott, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit the transfer credits that can be used toward requirements, **it is highly recommended that students work with both an OU (school/college) academic adviser and their Mott counselor to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.**

TRANSFERRING WITH THE MICHIGAN TRANSFER AGREEMENT (MTA):

When choosing to complete MTA to satisfy General Education, please confirm the best courses to take to fulfill the agreement with your academic adviser at Mott or at the [Mott MTA Approved Courses](#) website. In order to completely satisfy OU's transferable General Education requirements when following this major guide, please reference the [Mott General Education Transfer Guide](#) and select one course from OU's **Knowledge Applications** category (***this category met when a 200-level language course is taken above***).

Additional course requirements for MTA when following this major guide (minimum 30 credit hours required for MTA):

- ENGL 101 (MTA Approved Composition Course)
- ENGL 102 (MTA Approved Composition Course; this is a prerequisite for coursework at OU)
- Two MTA Approved Social Science Courses
- Two MTA Approved Natural Science Courses
- One MTA Approved Mathematics Course

TRANSFERRING WITHOUT MTA:

If you intend to transfer without MTA, you can choose to complete additional coursework to fulfill OU's individual General Education categories instead. EXPLORATORY REQUIREMENT:

Students with majors in the College of Arts and Sciences (CAS) must satisfy an exploratory requirement. This can be done by completing a double major or a CAS minor or concentration; or by completing a minimum of 12 credits in a single CAS rubric, outside of their major rubric. For additional options visit oakland.edu/exploratory. Please confirm transfer course choices with an OU CAS adviser. ***Students using MTA or MACRAO must complete the exploratory requirement at Oakland University or another four-year institution.***

NOTES:

Oakland University will always honor the **MACRAO transfer agreement** and apply it to the General Education requirement the same as MTA.

The College of Arts and Sciences requires that a minimum of 16 credits in the major be completed at Oakland University.
