Oakland University Requirements	Oakland Community College Options
Select up to 3 courses from this list of English/Creative Writing Electives:	ENG 2300, 2510, 2520, 2550, 2560, 2570, 2770, 2780, 2800, 2820; HUM 2720, 2900 (only one of the 3 course selections may come from these: ENG 1610, 1710, 1720, 2540, 2750, 2760)

MAJOR COREQUISITES

(select from the two options below)

Choose an introductory two-semester foreign language sequence OR an introductory two-semester sequence in sign language	ARB, GER, ITA, FRE, JPN, SPA 1510 and 1530 OR SLI 1000 and 1010 <i>(Chinese two-semester sequence may be started at OCC by taking CHI 1510)</i>
One semester foreign language at the second semester or higher OR one semester sign language at the second semester or higher	ARB, GER, ITA 1530; FRE, JPN, SPA 1530, 2610 or 2620; OR SLI 1010, 1020 or 1030

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from OCC, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit the transfer credits that can be used toward requirements, **it is highly recommended that students work with both an OU (school/college) academic adviser and their OCC counselor to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.**

TRANSFERRING WITH THE MICHIGAN TRANSFER AGREEMENT (MTA):

When choosing to complete MTA to satisfy General Education, please confirm the best courses to take to fulfill the agreement with your academic adviser at OCC or at the [OCC MTA Approved Courses](#) website. In order to completely satisfy OU's transferable General Education requirements when following this major guide, please reference the [OCC General Education Transfer Guide](#) and select one course from OU's **Knowledge Applications** category (**this category met when any 2000-level language course is taken above**).

ENG 1520 (MTA Approved Communications Course; this is a prerequisite for coursework at OU)

TRANSFERRING WITHOUT MTA:

If you intend to transfer without MTA, you can choose to complete additional coursework to fulfill OU's individual General Education categories instead. EXPLORATORY REQUIREMENT:

Students with majors in the College of Arts and Sciences (CAS) must satisfy an exploratory requirement. This can be done by completing a double major or a CAS minor or concentration; or by completing a minimum of 12 credits in a single CAS rubric, outside of their major rubric. For additional options visit oakland.edu/exploratory . Please confirm transfer course choices with an OU CAS adviser. ***Students using MTA or MACRAO must complete the exploratory requirement at Oakland University or another four-year institution.***

NOTES:

Oakland University will always honor the **MACRAO transfer agreement** and apply it to the General Education requirement the same as MTA.

The College of Arts and Sciences requires that a minimum of 16 credits in the major be completed at Oakland University.
