

# Bachelor of Arts with a major in English Language Arts for Educators

Students interested in continuing towards a secondary education certification will transition into the <a href="English Language Arts for Educators">English Language Arts for Educators</a>, B.A./Teaching in Secondary Education, MAT, Combined B.A./MAT. At the undergraduate level, the Combined BA/MAT program allows students to apply for and receive delayed admission into the MAT program.

#### **MAJOR COREQUISITES**

Choose an introductory two-semester foreign language sequence <i>OR</i> an introductory two-semester sequence in sign language	ARB, GER, ITA, FRE, JPN, SPA 1510 <u>and</u> 1530 or SLI 1000 <u>and</u> 1010 (Chinese two-semester sequence may be started at OCC by taking CHI 1510)
One semester foreign language at the second semester or higher  OR one semester sign language at the second semester or higher	ARB, GER, ITA 1530; FRE, JPN, SPA 1530, 2610 <i>or</i> 2620; SLI 1010, 1020 <i>or</i> 1030

<sup>\*</sup>Please Note: Education majors must complete WRT 1060 (or its equivalent) with a minimum grade of B or 3.0.

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from OCC, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit the transfer credits that can be used toward requirements, it is highly recommended that students work with both an OU (school/college) academic adviser and their OCC counselor to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.

### TRANSFERRING WITH THE MICHIGAN TRANSFER AGREEMENT (MTA):

When choosing to complete MTA to satisfy General Education, please confirm the best courses to take to fulfill the agreement with your academic adviser at OCC or at the OCC MTA Approved Courses website. Completing MTA when following this major guide will satisfy OU's transferrable General Education requirements.
