

## Bachelor of Arts with a major in Integrated Science

Students interested in continuing towards **Secondary Education Teacher Certification** will transition into the <u>Combined Bachelor of Arts (BA)/Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT)</u>. At the undergraduate level, the Combined BA/MAT program allows students to apply for and receive delayed admission into the MAT program.

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from OCC, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit the transfer credits that can be used toward requirements, it is highly recommended that students work with both an OU (school/college) academic adviser and their OCC counselor to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.

#### TRANSFERRING WITH THE MICHIGAN TRANSFER AGREEMENT (MTA):

When choosing to complete MTA to satisfy General Education, please confirm the best courses to take to fulfill the agreement with your academic adviser at OCC or at the OCC MTA Approved Courses website. Completing MTA when following this major guide will satisfy OU's transferrable General Education requirements.

# Additional course requirements for MTA when following this major guide (minimum 30 credit hours required for MTA):

ENG 1510 or 1510E (MTA Approved Composition course)

ENG 1520 (MTA Approved Communications Course; prerequisite for OU coursework – *B/3.0 minimum*) Two MTA Approved Social Science Courses (*one of these is met when GEO 1510 is chosen above*)

Two MTA Approved Fine Arts/Humanities Courses

## **TRANSFERRING WITHOUT MTA:**

If you intend to transfer without MTA, you can choose to complete additional coursework to fulfill OU's individual General Education categories instead.
