Students interested in continuing towards a secondary education certification will transition into the <u>Mathematics</u> <u>for Educators, B.S./Teaching in Secondary Education, MAT, Combined B.S./MAT.</u> At the undergraduate level, the Combined BS/MAT program allows students to apply for and receive delayed admission into the MAT program.

*Please Note: Education majors must complete WRT 1060 (or its equivalent) with a minimum grade of B or 3.0.

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from OCC, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit the transfer credits that can be used toward requirements, <u>it is</u> <u>highly recommended that students work with both an OU (school/college) academic adviser and their OCC</u> <u>counselor to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.</u>
