TRANSFERRING WITH THE MICHIGAN TRANSFER AGREEMENT (MTA):

When choosing to complete MTA to satisfy General Education, please confirm the best courses to take to fulfill the agreement with your counselor at OCC or at the [OCC MTA Approved Courses](#) website. If you intend to complete MTA when following this major guide, take (COM 1600, PHY 1620, PHY 2500, or PSY 2740) or select another course from OU's **Knowledge Applications** category in order to satisfy OU's transferable General Education requirements.

Additional course requirements for MTA when following this major guide (min 30 credit hours required for MTA):

- ENG 1510 **and** ENG 1520 (required prerequisite for coursework at OU)
- One MTA Approved Math course (can be satisfied by MAT elective options above)
- One MTA Approved Natural Sciences course (can be satisfied by CHE or PHY elective options above)
- One MTA Approved Social Sciences course (can be satisfied by SOC 2510)
- Two MTA Approved Humanities or Fine Arts courses (one course can be satisfied by SLI 1000)

TRANSFERRING WITHOUT MTA:

If you intend to transfer without MTA, you can choose to complete additional coursework to fulfill OU's individual General Education categories instead. NOTES:

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from OCC, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit how much transfer credit can be used toward requirements, **it is highly recommended that students work with both an OU academic adviser and their OCC counselor to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.**

Oakland University will always honor the **MACRAO transfer agreement** and apply it to the General Education requirement the same as MTA.
