MAJOR REQUIREMENTS

Oakland University Requirements	Schoolcraft College Options
Select 4 courses from this list of Approved English Electives:	ENG 243, 244, 245, 246, 251, 252 (only one of the 4 courses may come from these: ENG 120, 170, 248, 275)

Language Co-requisite (select one of the following options)

An introductory two-semester foreign language sequence	ARB, CHIN, FR, GER, ITAL, SPAN (101 and 102)
One second semester (or higher) foreign language course	ARB, CHIN, FR, GER, ITAL, SPAN (102, 201 <i>or</i> 202)

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from Schoolcraft, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit the transfer credits that can be used toward requirements, **it is highly recommended that students work with both an OU (school/college) academic adviser and their Schoolcraft counselor to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.**

TRANSFERRING WITH THE MICHIGAN TRANSFER AGREEMENT (MTA):

When choosing to complete MTA to satisfy General Education, please confirm the best courses to take to fulfill the agreement with your academic adviser at Schoolcraft or at the [Schoolcraft MTA](#) website. EXPLORATORY REQUIREMENT:

Students with majors in the College of Arts and Sciences (CAS) must satisfy an exploratory requirement. This can be done by completing a double major or a CAS minor or concentration; or by completing a minimum of 12 credits in a single CAS rubric, outside of their major rubric. For additional options visit oakland.edu/exploratory. Please confirm transfer course choices with an OU CAS adviser. ***Students using MTA or MACRAO must complete the exploratory requirement at Oakland University or another four-year institution.***

NOTES:

Oakland University will always honor the **MACRAO transfer agreement** and apply it to the General Education requirement the same as MTA.

The College of Arts and Sciences requires that a minimum of 16 credits in the major be completed at Oakland University.
