At the undergraduate level, the Combined BA/MAT program allows students to apply for and receive delayed admission into the MAT program.

*Please Note: Education majors must complete WRT 1060 (or its equivalent) with a minimum grade of B or 3.0.

Students may transfer an unlimited amount of credit from Schoolcraft, and must complete a minimum of 45 credit hours from OU to meet degree requirements. As programs may limit the transfer credits that can be used toward requirements, it is highly recommended that students work with both an OU (school/college) academic adviser and their Schoolcraft counselor to maximize the applicability of coursework to specific requirements.

TRANSFERRING WITH THE MICHIGAN TRANSFER AGREEMENT (MTA):

When choosing to complete MTA to satisfy General Education, please confirm the best courses to take to fulfill the agreement with your academic adviser at Schoolcraft or at the <u>Schoolcraft MTA</u> website. Completing MTA when following this major guide will satisfy OU's transferrable General Education requirements.
