<p><b>Summer</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Major/Minor/Gen Ed coursework if needed</li> </ul>	<p><b>Summer</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Any remaining Major/Minor/Gen Ed coursework</li> <li>(If taking SE401 or RDG338 here, there will be a required 30 hour field placement)</li> </ul> <p><b>All major, minor and general education courses as well as the MTTC test in the major and minor <u>must</u> be completed before student teaching in the Fall.</b></p>	<p><b>Summer</b></p> <p><b>Apply for and be recommended for certification.</b></p>
