

**Scholarship Opportunities
For
Environmental Health and Safety and Safety Management Students**

- 1) Environmental Safety and Health Program scholarships for full-time undergraduate and graduate students. Due beginning of April each year and awarded the following academic year. Apply through the EHS Program Director.
- 2) The [National Safety Council](#) is happy to announce the following new additions to our Scholarship Program. Students studying safety are eligible to apply for these scholarships:
 - a. Congress & Expo Scholarship
 - i. Helps students attend the NSC Congress & Expo by paying expenses for this event.
 - b. Women in Safety Scholarship
 - i. Up to \$5,000 tuition award for women studying safety (traditional in-person classroom attendance, non-traditional or online)
 - ii. Associates or bachelor's programs qualify
 - c. Billy D. Young Scholarship—Sponsored by the Construction & Utilities Division, this award is in memory of the founder of the Public Utilities Division.
 - i. Up to \$2,000 tuition award for individuals interested in pursuing a career in safety
 - ii. Technical, community college programs and undergraduate programs are all eligible
- 3) [Board of Certified Safety Professionals \(BCSP\)](#) scholarship for students in a Qualified Academic Program in Environmental Health and Safety. Apply through the EHS Program Director.
- 4) [Michigan Safety Conference Scholarship](#)
 - a. Each year the Michigan Safety Conference through its' scholarship program provides financial assistance to students enrolled in occupational safety and health curriculums at colleges and universities in the State of Michigan. Applicants are selected based on academic achievement, leadership, letters of recommendation and additional criteria. Scholarship recipients often become leaders in the fields of safety and health, and give back by serving as a volunteer of the Michigan Safety Conference.
- 5) [American Society of Safety Engineers](#) Scholarships and Grants
 - a. Since 1990, the ASSE Foundation has awarded more than \$2.3 million in scholarships and professional education grants to students beginning their studies in occupational safety and professionals seeking to continue their education. We offer more than 100 awards each year ranging from \$500 to \$15,000 each. More than 1,100 safety students and professionals have advanced their careers, thanks to the generosity of the safety community.
