### OLD BUSINESS

2. SHS - Proposal - Modification to Health Sciences, B.S.
  - A. Add SOC 1010 as an alternate for PSY 1000 in the core requirements.
  - B. Decrease credits from 4 to 3 for the following courses: HS 3400; HS 4430; HS 4440; HS 4450; HS 4460
  - C. Move HS 3500 to the core requirements for all concentrations.
  - D. Renumber HS 2250 to HS 3250
  - E. Holistic Health Concentration: Require HS 4460, formerly an elective to
    - a. No longer require PSY 3180 as required
    - b. Remove HS 4410 (4 credits) requirements and replaced with HS 3410 (3 credits)
    - c. Remove HS 4420 as elective.
  - F. Pre-Health Professions:
    - a. Add CDS 4050 as elective
  - G. Effective AY 22-23, HS 3250 will be required for all concentrations; PSY 2250 and PSY 2500 will be moved to elective courses
