Attached you will find a summary of activity as well as detailed listings of grants made during 1975-1976 from the University Research Fund and the Undergraduate Research Fund.

Perhaps the most interesting development of the year was the introduction of a summer research fellowship program (Type A) for "those members of the faculty who have been working in a particular project area and are at the stage where analysis and synthesis are more crucial than collection of data or material." The Committee feels that it now offers a fairly complete spectrum of grants, extending from support for the initiation of new scholarly efforts to the analysis and publication of results.

In its call for proposals dated September 15, 1975, the Committee increased the level of support available for travel reimbursement and for the purchase of reprints, in recognition of the rising costs of both items.

We are grateful to the Oakland University Alumni Association which has raised its level of support for undergraduate research grants to \$2,000 a year. A table is appended indicating the level of activity in that competition, and listing the names of recipients, project titles, and sponsors.

Once again, the University Research Committee has had a busy year and we are pleased by the results of its careful deliberations. We extend our appreciation and best wishes to our colleagues on the Committee--Sheldon Appleton, Carlo Coppola, Kenneth Harmon, Eileen Hitchingham, G. Philip Johnson, Cecelia Klein (who served during the winter semester), Lyle Nordstrom (fall semester), David Smith, and Anne Tripp.
