SUBJECT: Annual Report of University Research Committee, 1977-78

Attached is a detailed listing of individual grants made during 1977-78 from the University Research Fund and the Alumni Association Undergraduate Research Fund.

In addition to the regular small grants and research fellowship programs, the Committee, this year, offered support to individual departments and department-like units for the purchase of library research materials. The five grants made, for a total of \$9,720, represent, in our view, a substantial addition to the growing store of primary and secondary reference materials available to our faculty and students.

The Office of Research Services, with the support of the Provost and the Committee, produced the second in a continuing series of annual bibliographies listing faculty and staff contributions to arts, letters, and sciences. We have seen growing use of this document, both on and off campus, and response continues to be favorable.

We would like to express once more our gratitude to the Oakland University Alumni Association for continuing support of the undergraduate research grant program. This effort promises to become more extensive as students currently enrolled in the Honors College reach junior and senior status.

During the year the Committee assisted Dr. Pino as he developed a revised statement on Patent Policy and Procedures for Oakland University. That document has now been accepted by the President and his staff and will be going to the Board of Trustees within the next few months.

The Committee was called on to advise the Provost on his selection of a theme for the first research conference to be funded by Meadow Brook Hall. In all, eight proposals were submitted and the Provost, with the advice of the Committee, selected Molecular Mechanisms of Steroid Hormone Action submitted by Professor Roy and associates.

You will note in the grants listing a new category entitled "Discretionary Typing Assistance." This effort to improve access to typing services for those with completed work, ready for submission, has worked well and will, in all probability, be continued.

For the record, the members of the hard-working committee for 1977-78 were Jean Braun, Carlo Coppola, David Evans, Alice Gorlin, G. Philip Johnson, Lewis N. Pino, Peter Schmidt, Irwin Schochetman, Beth Titus, and Gertrude White.
