1. Appeals reviewed for academic dismissal.

The Committee reviewed slightly over 400 appeals from students subject to dismissal during Summer '79, Fall '79 and Winter '80.

273 resulted in dismissal.

184 were placed in the dismissal option program and are required to meet specified standards to avoid dismissal.

- 2. Change in grading policy. Preliminary work has been completed in preparation for recommending to the Senate that the N grade be dropped. More of this during the 80-81 academic year.
- 3. The Committee was particularly gratified by student participation in the Committee's activities. Special mention must be given to Deborah Moore whose participation was outstanding.
