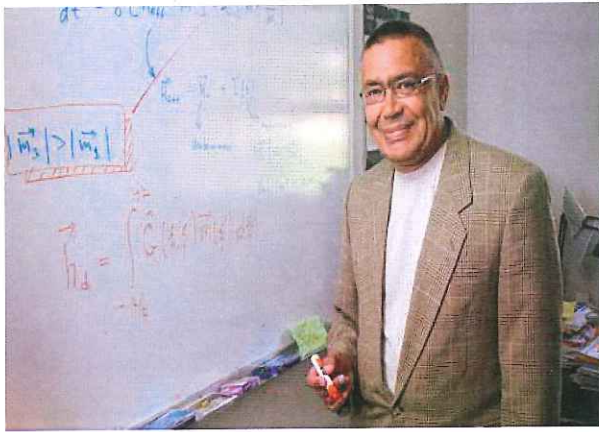

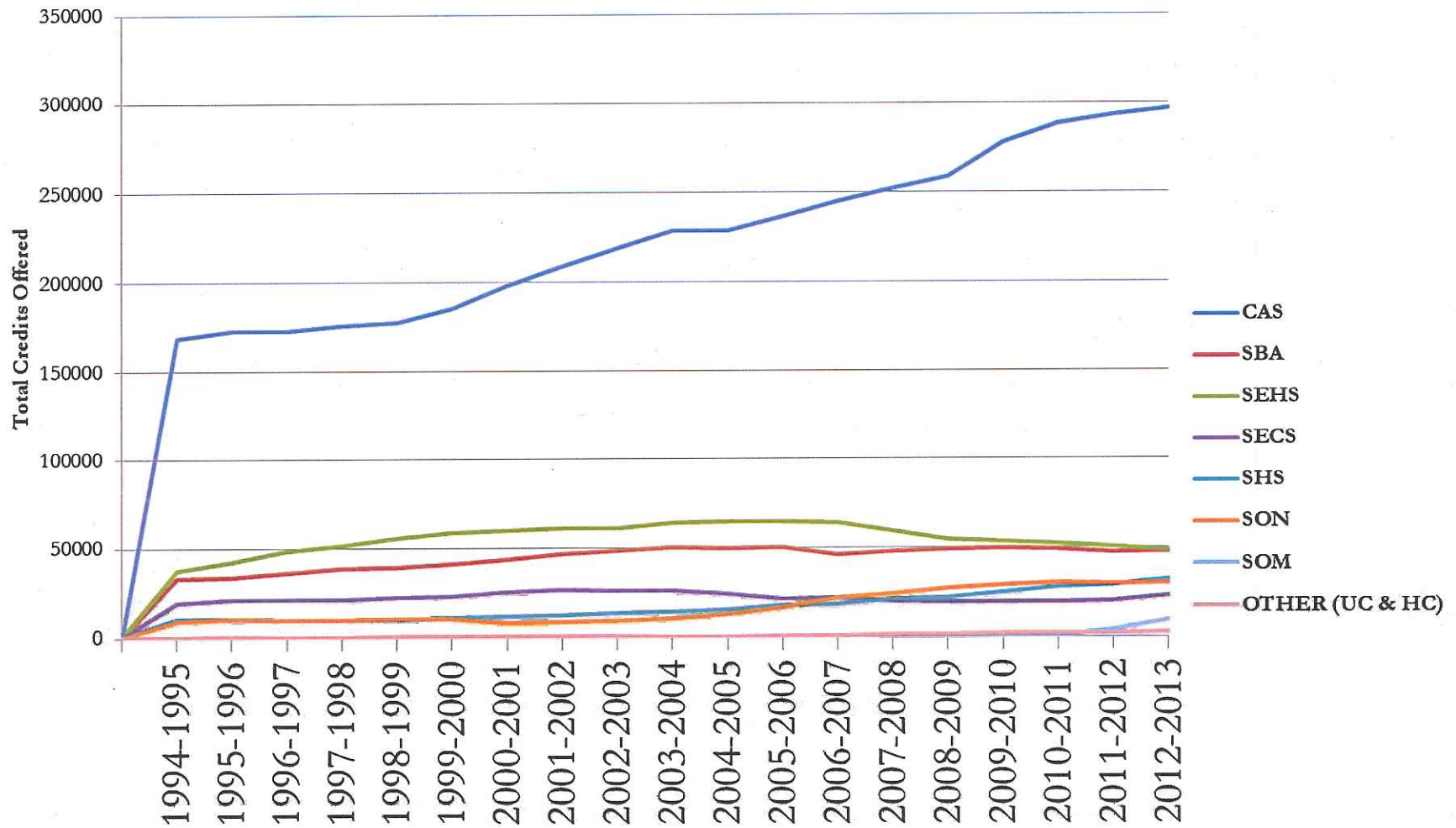


# The College by the numbers

- Six Doctoral degree programs

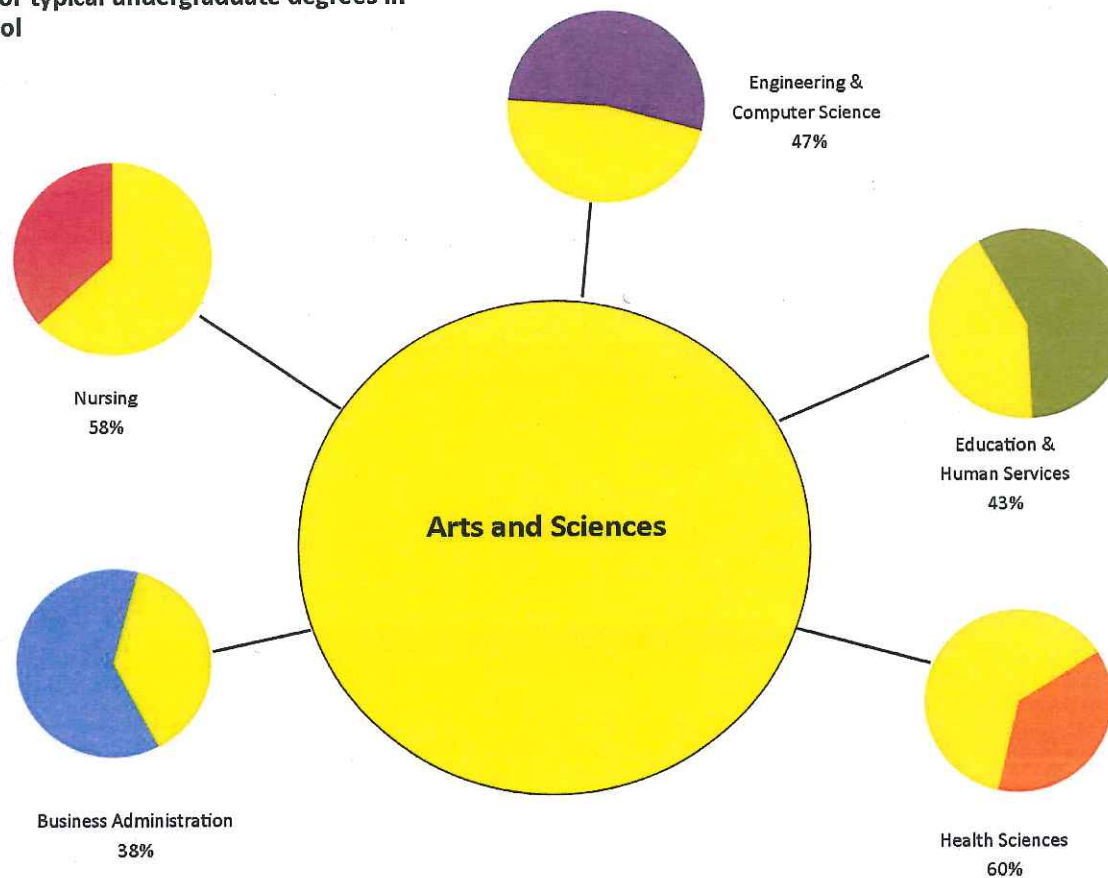


# Credit hours by College/School (1994-2013)

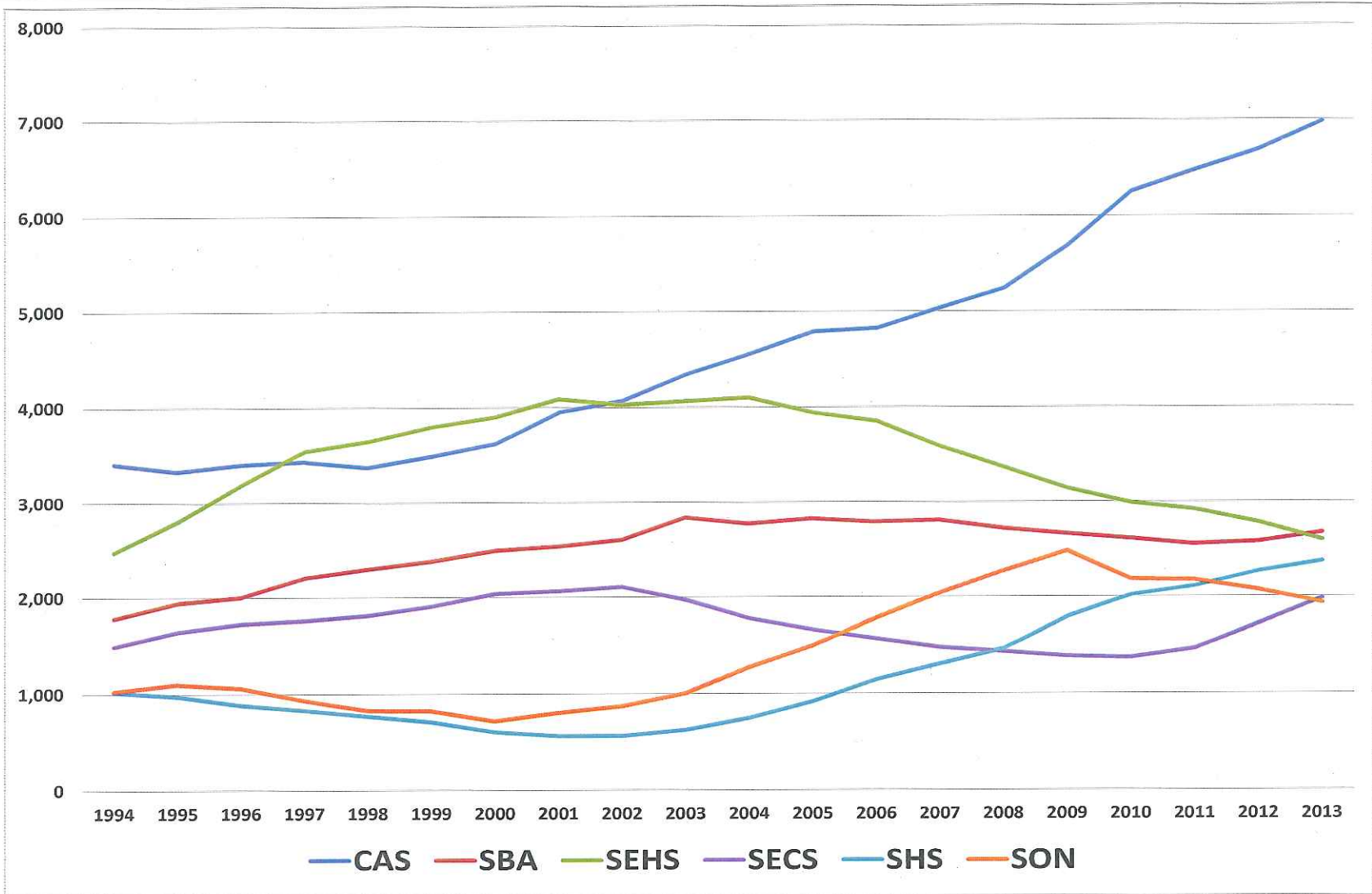


# College “in service” to Schools

# Faculty Research (*a few examples*)

- Role of cancer stem cells in leukemia relapse Goal: develop new treatments.
- Animal cognition: Goal: identify similarities and differences between humans and other species.
- Mathematical model of HIV dynamics—found to be consistent with clinical trials.
- Understanding physics of nano devices for memory in computers—making them smaller and more powerful.
- Understanding characteristics and role of proteins found in Alzheimer's disease.

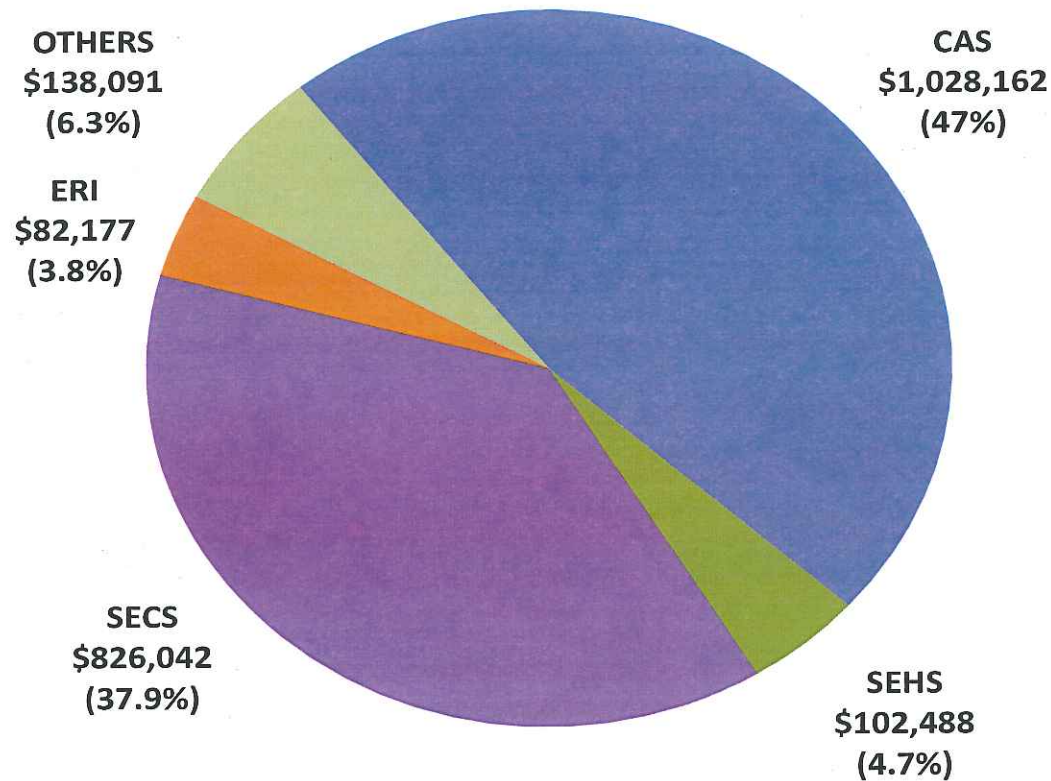
